Piece: Sideboard

Subject: Fitting the drawer runners.

I laid out the drawer runners exactly where they were to go and then I used my marking knife to scribe a line along each long side. I used my hand held router to rout to a depth of 3.6mm. I clamped a fence to the panel to help me cut right to the scribed line. I then used a sharp chisel to clean up the corners I then cut the runners 0.5mm over length and shot them to a perfect fit. After they were glued in they were left 0.4mm proud of the veneered surface. I will then hand plane the runner to very near level with the veneered surface. A light sand will flush the runners to the surface.
