Piece: Sideboard

Subject: Flushing the drawer runners.

The drawer runners were left 0.4mm proud. I then used my hand plane to carefully flush these so that the top surface of the drawer support was completely flat. I checked regularly with my straight edge to ensure I was not introducing any bumps.



Once I had planed all of the drawer runners flush I then used my Festool orbital sander to give the entire a very light sand with 240 grit sandpaper.



As this piece (and the left and right drawer supports) had its underside prepared to house hinges, door stops and door catches; all that remained was to prepare the housings for the drawer stops and the piece was ready to be polished and then glued up into the carcass.
