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Piece: Sideboard

Subject: Carcass Glue-Up 6.

Carcass glue-up 6 is gluing the central carcass, with the front and back top rails fixed, onto the front and back lower rails. To do this I have dry assembled the two end frames to the lower long rails so that I am gluing this central carcass onto the rails as they will be when the entire piece is glued. Before I do this glue-up I need to place the sideboard base into the carcass as it is sitting on a rebated edge routed onto the top of all of the lower rails.

This is the reason that I used dominoes to join the top and back long rails to the two end frames – so that I could glue this central section in and have the entire piece clamped as if it were one. Once it is glued I can then slide each end frame off and glue them to their top and bottom long rails individually (it is all about manageable glue-ups).









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
